And when we used to go to pick the food, they not only help us with food, but also some money and clothes. We distributed the foods and made saline water for them with the money left in hand.

1993

A winter dark night while I was sleeping, suddenly I used to hear a voice of an old man crying for food. I felt really bad for him, so I went with warm cloth and some cash from my pocket money and gave him.

1995

A woman in my neighbor used to live in a flat where there was no electricity, water or gas. She used bring water from so far because the tap in the area wasn't working. One day that woman came to me and told me if I could manage to fix the tap it would be helpful for her and even for the people in area. Then I managed to fix the tap with the help of some senior citizens in the area. The woman was so thankful and her smile motivated me to work for more people in the future.

1999

I went to visit my younger uncle who was sick and admitted in the hospital. I felt hungry and went to eat something in a hotel. While I was eating singara I saw a old woman eating rice with pepper, onion and dal only. I felt very bad for her because I couldn't do anything for her that time. After that I've done many works for people.

2005

I went to register for an organization to a join stock company. First time they denied because I was very young for that. Then I went to meet the senior worker, he gave me the same reason that I was very

2007

Aila seadoor hitted Bangladesh, that time we donated lots of food at Sundarban and patuwakhali with the help of our organization. I got a healthy lifestyle certificate for some social activities.

2008

I've started anti drug awareness programs at different places and places where drugs are been sold we're trying to fight against it to remove it from our society. We also did rally and seminar for anti tobacco awareness. And we did art & poem competition among children for National Language day. For 150th year of Mitford hospital we created an event of free blood donation and musical program. Nargis seadoor hit Bangladesh, then we created a camp and distributed food among the victims in our area.

2009

A foreigner organization sent me a donor letter to do social work from our NGO. And government game me the permission and clearance from NGO Bureau. After 1 year I got this registration paper. Then it becomes easy for me to work and my NGO got stronger than before. While doing such social works I had to go through many life threatened situation and neglected by a lot of people still I went through and never looked back.

We did an event on international day against drug abuse & illicit trafficking. Special guest was MP Mostafizur Rahman. Sub guest was MP Advocate Sanjida Khanom and some other guests.

2016

We did a awareness program in school with teachers, students and parents for drugs, terrorism and social development. And we did this awareness programs in different schools. We also motivated to aware others from drugs, terrorism and to serve the society.

2014 & 2019

My grandfather stand for election in the year of 1959 and my father stand for election at the year of 1978. They also used to do social works and that inspired me a lot. I also wanted to stand on election for councilor position so that I can help the society more than before. But some situations made me to withdraw my name from this election. Since 2014 I'm doing the responsibility of management committee at Mitford. I've worked against the agents who used to create trouble among patients and I've aware patients in the hospital because it there were thefts who used to stole money, mobile and even new born babies. We donated a wheel chair to a disable beggar child.

2020

Bangladesh got hit by a pandemic named Covid - 19. But we didn't sit back, we did many activates such as we alerted peoples, we disinfected the roads, we distributed food to the needy peoples for 15 days. Even the season of dengue arrived; we tried to diminish it with medicines. I've worked against the shopkeepers who used to sell duplicate masks, sanitizers etc. In this pandemic times road outside the Mitford hospital becomes so crowded because of the little shops on the footpath, leading the patience to have trouble while going to the hospital and even the patience who came just to test for Covid - 19. When I tried to fix this problem, I had to go though many threats then sent a letter to Dhaka south city corporation, Dhaka metro police commissioner and the director of Mitford hospital but it didn't worked

yet. After getting the responsibility of community ambassador of south city corporation, the landlords who built their house over the drain way, which caused drain blockage and roads were flooded by the drain water, it also trouble the people to walk on the road. There was a fear of dengue for this flooded water. Then I fixed and rebuilt the drain way but the landlords were unhappy about that and tried to threat me. Still I continued my work.
